

# Counselor Education Programs

## North Carolina Central University

- The 48 hour Career Counseling program is the only CACREP online career program in the nation & one of nine CACREP accredited programs in the United States. Our program prepares students to work as career counselors in colleges and other academic settings.
- The Mental Health Program consists of 60 hours of course work. Our program prepares students to work in non-profit, private, and other mental health settings. The curriculum prepares students for application as Licensed Professional Counselors in NC.
- Our 51 hour School Counseling program prepares students for K-12 licensure in North Carolina to practice as professional school counselors.

### NCCU

- We feature late afternoon, evening, and online classes.
- We have a career counseling CACREP endorsed online program.
- Every student completes 700 hours of supervised field experience before graduating.
- We have seven fulltime counselor education faculty with other affiliate faculty.
