

Job Opening - Upper School College Guidance Counselor

Carolina Friends School seeks a full-time Upper School College Guidance Counselor to begin on or about August 1, 2015. This position is eligible for a full employee benefits package.

The Upper School College Guidance Counselor will be fully responsible for facilitating the college search process for Carolina Friends School students. In addition to annually counseling 40-50 students through the college application process, the College Guidance Counselor will educate students and families about all aspects of planning and managing a college and career search process. The College Guidance Counselor also teaches 1-2 classes in the Upper School and serves as an advisor for a group of about 10 students. The College Guidance Counselor reports to, and works closely with, the Upper School Head Teacher.

Detailed Responsibilities

Ø Providing education and information about the college search process to families on both an individualized and community levels. Manages appropriate programming for students and parents at each stage of their upper school experience.

 \emptyset Works closely with each family starting in the spring of the Junior year through college decisions in the spring of Senior year.

Ø Maintains records of student applications, complete and in process; records and analyzes acceptance data, matriculations, financial aid awards and scholarships in Naviance.

- Ø Facilitates appropriate and effective use of Naviance by CFS students and families.
- Ø Writes College Counselor Letter for each student.
- Ø Assists students with essay writing and interview preparation.
- Ø Arranges for college representative visits to CFS.

Ø Co-ordinates with coaches and the athletic director regarding athletic recruitment, and communicates with NCAA about CFS curriculum.

- Ø Assists advisors in course selection choices as necessary.
- Ø Communicates to families about standardized testing options and dates.
- Ø Serves as AP-Coordinator and oversees AP test administration.
- Ø Clerks staff conversations regarding scholarship nominations and Governor's School.
- Ø Communicates to parents and staff about all aspects of the college admissions process.
- Ø Maintains and updates the Upper School Profile.

 \emptyset Guides staff in the writing of teacher recommendations, and manages the collection of teacher recommendations.

Ø Serves on Upper School Academic Council.

 \varnothing Attends Weekly Upper School Staff Meetings and other duties as required by the Upper School Head Teacher.
