The Doctor of Behavioral Health program curriculum requires 57 credit hours (19 courses) for completion. Two tracks will be offered, 1) clinical track, and 2) administrative track. The program offers a common core curriculum for both tracks consisting of 42 credit hours (14 courses), as well as 15 credit hours (5 courses) specific to the track chosen by the student.

Clinical Track: 14 core courses (42 credits) + 5 clinical track courses (15 credits) = 57 Total

Administrative Track: 14 core courses (42 credits) + 5 admin. track courses (15 credits) = 57 Total
